BEFORE SELECTION (As early as possible – November 2022)

If applicable, start preparing or apply for language courses, intakes/assessments.
Check deadlines and register for the TOEFL (www.toefl.org) or IELTS (www.ielts.org), the
academic version, in time. Make the TOEFL test before September and the IELTS no
later than the 22nd of October to have the original certificate in time. But register well in
time as spots at the test centres fill up quickly! Note that the certificate needs to be send
to your home address, NOT to the university. You'll need to upload a scan of the origina
in the application before de deadline in November.
The online application form (Part I) and Interview Stream (Part II) will be accessible as of
01 October 2022. Part I can be started from: www.rsm.nl/exchange/application . Start
filling out the form already and save it every time you've entered something. Upload all
necessary documents; incomplete application forms will not be processed!
As soon as you submit, no changes can be made! You will receive a pop-up message to
confirm that you submitted the form successfully, the option to save a pdf of your
application (highly recommended) and the link to Interview Stream (Part II). Save this link
as well unless you immediately want to complete Part II as well. Part II: If you saved the link to this part of your application, you can start whenever you
want to, as long as you complete it before the deadline of 10 November 2022. Do note,
that this part will have to be completed in one go.
Attend the information sessions on Bachelor Exchange in September and in October
(for 2 nd year bachelor students only), the latter will be offered at the Study & Internship
Abroad Fair.
Visit the Study & Internship Abroad Fair on 04 October 2022. It will be held in the Theil
building, C-Hall from 14:00 to 18:00 hrs. More information on the sessions (time and
how to register) can be found in the announcements on Canvas.
The fair is for students who are in their 1st and 2nd year of their bachelor programme, the
session during the fair is for 2 nd year bachelor students only. Attend both sessions as
they are different from one another!
